Parents Code Of Conduct

Membership in the Wayzata Soccer Club (WSC) and attendance at MYSA sponsored events is a privilege and not a right. As with all privileges there comes the responsibility to maintain that privilege. One of your responsibilities as a representative of the WSC is to conduct yourself in a way that reflects positively on yourself, your child's team, the WSC and the game of soccer. The WSC strives to maintain a reputation for a high level of sportsmanship. Achieving this starts with you! Parents who do not conduct themselves appropriately may be subject to discipline (by either the WSC or the MYSA) that could include up to removal from the club and/or attendance at MYSA sponsored events. Listed below are some of the behaviors you are expected to exhibit at all times:

1. I will control my language and not use foul or inappropriate language while attending soccer-related activities.
2. I will remember that the game is for the players and not adults.
3. I will have my child arrive on time for all practices and games. I will notify the coach whenever there is a problem in attending a scheduled event.
4. I will let the coach, coach, and not yell directions from the sidelines.
5. I will talk to the coach privately and not in front others if issues arise.
6. I will respect the opposing team and not cause or seek out any confrontation.
7. I will respect the game officials and not make comments from the sidelines about decisions made on the pitch. I will remember that they are in control of the pitch and acknowledge that they are human and will make mistakes. Open confrontation with the officials in the end will not serve my child's team or me well. The officials will have the last word even if it results in coaches/players/parents being sent off the pitch.
8. I will only shout words of encouragement from the sidelines and I will cheer for all players.
9. I will not encourage any behavior that would endanger the health or well being of the athlete.
10. I will value skill development, fair competition and effort.
11. I will try at all times to follow all WSC and MYSA rules and policies.
12. I will follow the rules of the game at all times.

I have read and understand the WSC Parents Code of Conduct. I understand that any violation of this code may result in disciplinary action being taken against me. This code of conduct will be enforced for the current soccer season.
